DIRECTIONS FOR A SOCRATIC SEMINAR ...

The desks will be set with one smaller circle inside of a larger circle. The outside circle is the "observation circle." The desks in the inside circle are called the "hot seats."

We will begin our discussion with a question. ONLY the students in the "hot seats" can speak! Students will rotate in and out the of the "hot seats" so that everyone has a turn to be in them and to speak.

Rules for discussion:

When you are in the "hot seats":

- 1) Listen to your classmates! Don't interrupt!
- 2) Make your point once and support your idea with facts.
- 3) Ask questions to your classmates to clarify what they have said.
- 4) Be respectful!

When you are in the "observation circle":

- 1) You can't speak!
- 2) Listen closely to your classmates
- 3) Most importantly Take notes on what your classmates are saying!!! These notes will be useful to you when you are in the "hot seats."
